

Mulilo Danish Vocational Program, student information:

Examination at the Techcollege MDVP Composite Technology program

Dear student or applicant (prospective student),

You will notice from the program **Education Plan** and **Study Plan & Calendar** that the MDVP Composite Technology program is divided into a number of thematic **Modules** - specifically 8 modules within the Vocational component of the program (with a total duration of 34 weeks) and 6 modules within the Personal Growth & Leadership component (total duration: 4 weeks).

Assessment - but no testing and grading - in each module

At Techcollege, we will *assess* your performance in each separate module: how you participate actively during lessons and in completing exercises and project assignments - and the quality of your inputs in the classroom and the processes you perform in the workshop.

But we will assess you *only* in order to provide you with *advice and guidance on how and where you may improve your professional skills* within the theme of each module.

We will *not* test you with any formal examinations (neither in writing or orally) during the modules, and we will not issue grades for your performance.

One final Test Assignment & Presentation

The only vocational examination you will face in the program is the Final Test Assignment (Module 8 in the program Vocational Component – see Education Plan). In this assignment, you will show your skills across a 10-day work process, where you individually prepare and complete a practical assignment that simulates a real-life customer order for a composite product.

The Test Assignment will include a short multiple-choice written test of your material and production process knowledge, but the main part if the assignment will be all about planning and executing a production of a composite product to meet the customer's quality requirements.

At the end of the 10-day Test Assignment period, you will make a presentation of your work process and final product.

In a similar way, the Personal Growth & Leadership (PGL) component will conclude with a 2-day process where you prepare and present a presentation of your main learning outcomes and reflections from your participation in the component. This final presentation is PGL Module 6 (see Education Plan).

Grading and Certification

In each of the two final examinations (vocational and PGL components), you will present to your teacher and an examiner appointed by Techcollege. You will be awarded with the grade: "Passed" if your performance shows that you have met the program's proficiency goals (see goals for each module in the Education Plan) to a satisfactory extent. If not, you will be given the "Not Passed" grade.

If passed, Techcollege will issue your program completion Diploma, confirming your achieved non-formal (in the Danish education system) qualification as **Assistant Composite Technology Operator**. To showcase and distinguish your achievement towards future employers, we recommend that you use your developed program learning **Portfolio** of the experience and learning outcomes you have acquired though your participation in the program.
